Event description	This guided walk will take us along a level, well-surfaced path beside the rushing River Teign from Fingle to Clifford Bridge in the stunning wooded gorge below Castle Drogo. We'll hope for views of heron, kingfisher and dippers – our only diving and swimming songbird. There will be an optional diversion to Upperton Weir.
Distance:	5 miles (8 kms)
Parking and location of start point:	Park beside the road leading down to the Fingle Bridge Inn (EX6 6PW) The meeting point and start will be in the parking area on the opposite side of the river to the Fingle Bridge Inn. Please do not try to drive across the bridge, it is very narrow. Grid ref: SX743899
Toilet facilities:	There are toilets, including a disabled toilet in the parking area when the walk is starting.
Dog-friendly:	Dogs on leads
Day and date:	Sunday 1 st September
Start and finish time:	Meet at 10.30 for 11:00 start, finishing at approx. 15:00
What to bring:	A packed lunch and snacks. Water and a hot drink if weather is cool. Plenty of layers, waterproofs and whistle for emergencies
